Using Government Vehicles for Election Propaganda Campaigning

As per the reports submitted by Transparency International Sri Lanka's (TISL) District Observer, it has been observed that Mr. Ranjith Shantha Kahawala, Chairman of the Urban Settlement Development Authority of the Ministry of Housing, Construction and Cultural Affairs, had allegedly engaged in political campaigning during office hours on 4th October 2019 at the opening ceremony of the New Democratic Front's party office in Kandy (TISL has received evidence in this regard) and according to the District Observer, he has been allegedly using a state vehicle for similar purposes.

Direction No. 5 (i) of the Extraordinary Gazette No.2141/52 of 19th September 2019 stipulate that pool of vehicles belonging to the State including motor cars, jeeps, cabs and buses, should be taken extra care during the period of election so as to prevent such vehicles being used for the promotion of election propaganda campaigns of any political party, independent group or candidate and Direction 2 (i) stipulate that the officers who are entitled with political rights may engage in political activities during office hours, only on personal leave or special leave approved in advance. This therefore is a potential violation of the gazetted directions of the Election Commission.

Please be kind enough to look into this matter and take prompt action to ensure electoral integrity.
